The Lordstown Local School District is an outstanding public school with a great history. Our K-12 enrollment totals 528 which includes open enrollment from many districts in the Mahoning Valley. Lordstown Elementary houses grades K-6 and the High School houses grades 7-12. Lordstown Schools has a staff of 40 licensed/ certified teaching professionals. Our student/teacher ratio is approximately 12:1.

Students at the High School have the opportunity to take College Credit Plus courses from local colleges as well as in the LHS building. Beginning in 2015-16, we began offering our students an ACT Prep course and added several electives taught by our content experts. Junior and Senior students also have the option of pursuing a vocational or tech prep education at the Trumbull Career & Technical Center.

We offer a wealth of extracurricular activities including Destination Imagination, Lego League, Prep Bowl, Key Club, Power of the Pen, Political History Club and Mock Trial. In addition to these and other activities, our students in grades 7-12 have many opportunities to compete athletically on school sports teams governed by the Ohio High School Athletic Association.
